## What Can My Gift Do?

***Here are just a few examples of how YOUR workplace giving contribution to Alaska Community Share agencies can make a difference in the lives of Alaskans:***

- ❖ For \$1.00 per pay period you can help a fellow Alaskan receive assistance with shelter, advocacy, crisis intervention and counseling. **Or**, help prevent further degradation of our streams, lakes and wetlands.
- ❖ Three dollars per pay check is all it takes for Warren, a recovering stroke victim, to get one-on-one assistance for a month to help him pay his bills and balance his checkbook.
- ❖ 10 helps 10: Ten dollars every payday from you will allow ten youth receive the care and treatment they need to overcome substance abuse problems with alcohol or drugs.
- ❖ A gift of \$25 per pay check will help a working disadvantaged person who needs heat reinstated in her apartment **and** help promote our arts and culture through education and information.
- ❖ Health assistance can be costly, but just \$50 a pay period will help organizations provide advocacy, medical equipment loans, information and referrals to clients and their families. **Or**, help aid in providing research dollars for a variety of diseases that we once thought incurable.
- ❖ With a contribution of \$100.00 per pay check, you can literally change someone's life — someone like Delores, who is the parent of a child with disabilities, be able to receive assistance with respite care.
