### some notes from the office.

I hope everyone finds reviewing the Alaska Community Share 2010 Annual report as illuminating as I found preparing it.

2010 saw some employee turnover, with Drew Phoenix accepting a position with the American Civil Liberties Union of Alaska Foundation, Holly Kent serving as Interim Campaign Manager, and myself (Ed Bos) accepting the Executive Director position in the Fall of 2010.

The Board of Directors also decided to shift the organization's fiscal year (previously July-June) to match the calendar year (January-December). This meant there were two IRS filing periods and audit periods that had to be accounted for, and our recent audit includes the July 2008 – June 2009 fiscal year, and the July 2009 – December 2009 "short year" to get us on track.


All through the administrative and employee changes Alaska Community Share continued about the business of bringing workplace

giving to as many Alaskan businesses and agencies as will have us.

Some of the activities Alaska Community Share held to accomplish the task included:

- 11 Board of Director Meetings (none held in March 2010)
- A Peer-Review meeting held on February 18, 2010
- A Fall All-Member meeting held on August 25, 2010
- Several Campaign Kick-Off events held throughout Autumn 2010 (See Page 4 for an idea of where we campaign).

## How Workplace Giving Works

### In Public Campaigns:

Alaska Community Share assists member agencies in their applications and enrollment in the Following Public Campaigns:

- Combined Federal Campaign
- Alaska SHARE (State Employee) Campaign
- Anchorage Municipal Employee Campaign
- Anchorage School District Charitable Giving Campaign

As members of our federation, member agencies are listed together in published campaign materials that are presented as options to public-sector employees.

### In Private Campaigns:

Alaska Community Share makes presentations at "Campaign Kick Off" events each fall, often alongside a representative of the United Way. There an Alaska Community Share representative from the staff, Board of Directors, member agency, or from a different giving workplace explains a little about the federation, and explains how important this type of giving is to member agencies and the communities across Alaska.

### After the Campaign:

Alaska Community Share tallies up the pledges from the campaigns, and collects the contributions, making distributions throughout the year. Alaska Community Share "forward funds" its budget by withholding an appropriate amount (set by the Board of Directors) from the initial distributions, and once the annual budget is covered, the rest of the contributions are distributed to federation member agencies.

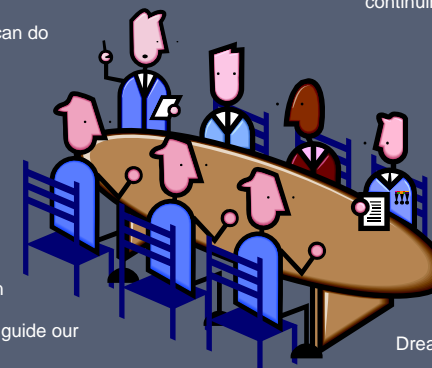
